



A message from SVCT's President...

On behalf of the South Valley Civic Theatre Board of Directors and the production staff, technical and artistic crew, and the cast, I welcome you to our production of *A Christmas Story*. Few stories have generated so much artistic interpretation and reinterpretation from a single short story. Author Jean Shepherd collected into his book, <u>In God We Trust: All Others Pay Cash</u>, short stories he had written for Playboy magazine during the 1960s. *A Christmas Story*, one of those stories, has been made into a feature film, a play, a stage musical, and now is being revisited in a sequel to the first movie. 


Mykal Philbin \sim Lighting Designer
